#### **Using the Instant Search Box**

- Search engine: Website designed to help you locate and navigate to web pages with desired information
- Instant Search box
  - ▲ Allows you to search without navigating to the search engine's homepage
  - ▲ Allows you to switch search engines quickly



Over time, you will likely find your favorite search engines to suit your various needs




## **Using the Instant Search Box**



#### Narrowing a Search


If a search yields too many hits, add additional search words ("narrow" your search)

0	Abou <mark>t 233,000 results</mark> (0.31 seconds)	Advanced search






These help you perform a specific type of search on text you select directly on a web page

Open multiple web pages within the same browser window



- ▲ Quickly go to the pages you visit most often



  - ▲ Selection (drag to set your preference)
  - ▲ Certain pages

#### **How Search Engines Work**

Full-text

▲ Every word of every page indexed

- Computer-generated
  - ▲ Assigned keywords
- Human-indexed
  - ▲ Reviewed, categorized, and rated



A metasearch engine sends your search to multiple search engines with a single command



#### Behind the Screen: The Order of Hits

- Defined by:
  - ▲ Content
    - Particularly on the homepage
  - ▲ Relevance rating
    - Determined by search engine
  - ▲ Meta-tag
    - Program code embedded in homepage
  - ▲ Money
    - Sites can pay to be listed first
